Electronics Policy

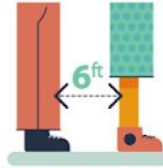

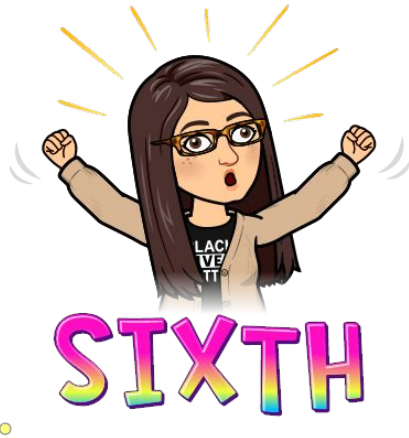
